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# Introduction

This document is a summary of data from the HRB National Psychiatric In-patient Reporting System (NPIRS) for 2009. Tables from the data are produced alongside this summary. These can be viewed in the list of tables from page 16 of this report. The tables present socio-demographic (gender, age, marital status, socio-economic group), diagnostic, legal category and length of stay variables by national and regional (HSE) admissions, by national discharges and deaths, by hospital type and by child and adolescent admissions. Data for individual units and hospitals are presented by all and first admissions for catchment areas, age and diagnosis, and for discharges and deaths. A report on the data for 2009 will not be produced.

Data in this summary capture all admissions to, discharges from, and deaths during 2009 in the 67 Irish psychiatric units and hospitals and child and adolescent units approved by the Mental Health Commission for the reception and treatment of patients. Comparative data for 2008 used in this summary are from the publication *Activities of Irish Psychiatric Units and Hospitals 2008* (Daly *et al.* 2009) and rates reported are per 100,000 total population. In the computation of rates for Health Service Executive (HSE) areas and for county, private hospital admissions are returned to their area of origin, i.e., the area/county from which they were admitted, and they are thus included in the rates for those areas/counties.

There were five additional centres reporting to the NPIRS database in 2009, following inclusion in the Register of Approved Centres under the Mental Health Act 2001 (Department of Health and Children, 2001). Two of these centres were specialist child and adolescent units. One private hospital closed in the first half of 2009.

# **Summary of key findings**

#### **National admissions**

There were 20,195 admissions to Irish psychiatric units and hospitals in 2009, representing a rate of 476.3 per 100,000 total population. This is a reduction in the number (20,752) and rate (489.5) of admissions from 2008. There was also a reduction in the number and rate of first admissions from 2008–2009, from 6,194 in 2008, a rate of 146.1 per 100,000 population, to 5,972 admissions in 2009, a rate of 140.9. Re-admissions, at 14,223, accounted for 70% of all admissions, representing no change from 2008.

Any change in admission numbers/rates should be viewed in the context of additional centres reporting to the NPIRS. Three of the five additional centres reporting to NPIRS in 2009 had a combined total of 149 admissions, with the remaining two child and adolescent units having a combined total of 33 admissions. Admissions to these two child and adolescent centres are not included in the above data but are included in the child and adolescent data below. In terms of the private hospital which closed in 2009, there were no admissions for 2009 and there were 31 discharges.

The rate of male and female all admissions was almost equal (476.8 for males and 475.9 for females), in contrast to the trend observed for many years, with males typically having a higher rate of admission than females, with the exception of 2007–2008. Males had a higher rate of first admission than females, at 151.3 per 100,000 population for males, and 130.4 for females.

The 45–54 year age group had the highest rate of all admissions, at 761.6 per 100,000, followed by the 35–44 year age group, at 702.4, and the 65–74 year age group, at 646.0. The 18–19 year age group had the lowest rate of all admissions, at 378.4. The 18–19 year age group had the highest rate of first admissions, at 225.8 per 100,000, followed by the 20–24 year age group, at 204.4, and the 35–44 year age group, at 191.8. The 55–64 year age group had the lowest rate of first admission, at 145.7.

Single persons accounted for over half of all (54%) and first (51%) admissions.

In keeping with the trend observed over many years, the unskilled occupational group had the highest rate of all (880.5) and first (195.1) admissions.

Depressive disorders were the most common cause of all admissions, accounting for 30% of all and 32% of first admissions, and had the highest rate of all (143.0) and first (45.1) admissions. Schizophrenia accounted for 20% of all admissions, while

mania accounted for 11% and alcoholic disorders for 10%. Admissions for depressive disorders, schizophrenia, mania and alcoholic disorders accounted for 71% of all admissions. Schizophrenia had the second-highest rate of first admissions, at 18.0 per 100,000, followed by neuroses, at 17.1, and alcoholic disorders, at 16.0.

There was no change in the proportion of involuntary all and first admissions from 2008–2009, at 8%. Similarly, there was little change in the rate of involuntary all admissions, at 38.5 per 100,000, and first admissions, at 11.9 in 2009, compared with 37.3 for all and 11.8 for first admissions in 2008. Admissions for schizophrenia had the highest rate of involuntary admission, at 17.6 (up from 15.5 per 100,000 in 2008), followed by mania, at 7.8, and depressive disorders, at 3.4.

There were 223 admissions for persons with no fixed abode in 2009, an increase from 2008 (179). Thirty-two per cent of those with no fixed abode were admitted with a diagnosis of schizophrenia, 15% had a diagnosis of alcoholic disorders and 14% had a diagnosis of other drug disorders.

# National discharges and deaths

There were 20,213 discharges from, and 159 deaths in, Irish psychiatric units and hospitals in 2009. Males accounted for almost two-thirds (65%) of all deaths in 2009, and 58% of those who died were aged 75 years and over.

Almost half (49%) of all discharges in 2009 occurred within two weeks of admission; 20% occurred within two to four weeks of admission and 24.5% occurred within one to three months of admission. Ninety-three per cent of all discharges occurred within three months of admission and, as in previous years, 2% of discharges occurred after one year or more in hospital. The average length of stay for all discharges, excluding those with a length of stay of one year or more, was 25.8 days (median 14 days).

## **HSE Areas – Admissions**

Twenty-seven per cent of all admissions in 2009 were resident in Dublin Mid-Leinster; 27% were resident in HSE South; almost 25% were resident in HSE West; and 21% were resident in Dublin North-East. HSE South had the highest rate of all admissions, at 508.0 per 100,000 population, followed by HSE West, at 488.6, and Dublin Mid-Leinster, at 453.0. Dublin North-East had the lowest rate of all admissions, at 449.1 per 100,000. HSE South had the highest rate of first admissions, at 151.4 per 100,000.

Females had higher rates of all admissions than males in Dublin Mid-Leinster (476.2 for females and 429.4 for males) and in Dublin North-East (465.1 for females and 433.1 for males). In contrast, males had higher rates than females in HSE South (530.4 for males and 485.3 for females) and HSE West (508.6 for males and 468.3 for females). Males had higher rates than females for first admissions in all HSE Areas, with rates ranging from 169.8 per 100,000 in HSE South to 137.4 in Dublin Mid-Leinster.

Rates for the 45 years and over age group were higher in all HSE areas than those for the under 45 year group, with rates ranging from 705.7 per 100,000 in Dublin North-East to 645.3 in HSE South. The rate of admission for the 45 years and over age group was twice that of the under 45 year group in both Dublin Mid-Leinster and Dublin North-East.

Depressive disorders had the highest rate of all and first admissions across all HSE areas, with rates for all admissions ranging from 159.7 per 100,000 in HSE South to 127.4 in Dublin North-East. Rates for first admissions ranged from 51.0 per 100,000 in HSE West to 39.7 in Dublin North-East. Schizophrenia had the second-highest rate of all admissions across all HSE areas, with rates ranging from 100.0 in Dublin Mid-Leinster to 82.1 in Dublin North-East.




Figure 1 Health Service Executive Areas. All admissions by selected diagnoses. Ireland 2009. Rates per 100,000 total population

HSE South had the highest rate of involuntary all admissions, at 43.7 per 100,000, followed by HSE West, at 41.5, and Dublin Mid-Leinster, at 35.7. Dublin North-East

had the lowest rate of involuntary all admissions, at 31.3. Dublin Mid-Leinster had the highest rate of involuntary first admissions, at 12.6, followed by HSE West, at 12.0.

# **HSE Areas – Discharges**

Twenty-nine per cent of all discharges for Dublin Mid-Leinster and for HSE West, 30.5% for HSE South and 31% of Dublin North-East occurred within one week of admission. Approximately two-thirds (and above in some areas) of all discharges for HSE areas occurred within one month of admission, while over 93% occurred within three months of admission. Discharges for Dublin Mid-Leinster had the longest average length of stay, at 27.6 days (median 15 days), followed by Dublin North-East, at 25.9 days (median 13 days), HSE South, at 24.9 days (median 13 days), and HSE West, at 24.7 days (median 13 days).

#### **Non-residents**

There were 69 admissions for non-residents in 2009. Forty-two per cent had an address originating in Northern Ireland, 30% had an address in England, 6% had an address in the United States and a further 6% had an address in Scotland. Twenty-nine per cent of non-residents had a diagnosis of schizophrenia, 14.5% had a diagnosis of mania, 12% had a diagnosis of eating disorders, 10% had a diagnosis of depressive disorders, while a further 10% had a diagnosis of personality disorders.

# **County of admission**

The highest rate of first admissions was recorded for persons resident in county Carlow, at 218.5 per 100,000, followed by Longford, at 200.6, Laois, at 198.3, and Roscommon, at 195.7. The lowest rates were observed in counties Monaghan (44.6) and Cavan (81.2). Admissions from persons resident in Tipperary South had the highest rate of admissions for depressive disorders, at 94.9; Sligo had the highest rate for alcoholic disorders, at 29.6; and Kerry had the highest rate for schizophrenia, at 34.3.

# **Hospital type**

Fifty per cent of all and 51% of first admissions were to general hospital psychiatric units. Twenty-nine per cent of all admissions were to public psychiatric hospitals (including the Central Mental Hospital, Dundrum; Carraig Mór, Cork; and St Joseph's Intellectual Disability Service, Portrane) and 21% were to private hospitals. Re-admissions accounted for 75% of all admissions to psychiatric hospitals, 70% of admissions to general hospital psychiatric units and 65% of admissions to private hospitals.

Over one-third (36%) of all admissions to private hospitals, 30% to general hospital psychiatric units and 25% to psychiatric hospitals had a diagnosis of depressive disorders. Proportions were similar for first admissions, with 36% of admissions to private hospitals, 32% of admissions to general hospital psychiatric units and 29% of admissions to psychiatric hospitals having a diagnosis of depressive disorders.

## Legal status

Ten per cent of all admissions to general hospitals and 10% of all admissions to psychiatric hospitals were involuntary, compared with 1.5% of admissions to private hospitals. Twelve per cent of first admissions to psychiatric hospitals, 10% of first admissions to general hospital psychiatric units and 1.6% of first admissions to private hospitals were involuntary.




Figure 2 Proportion of involuntary admissions by hospital type. Ireland 2009

# Length of stay according to hospital type

Over one-third of all discharges from general hospital psychiatric units (34%) and from psychiatric hospitals (35%) occurred within one week of admission, compared with 13% of discharges from private hospitals. Over half of all discharges from general hospital psychiatric units (54%) and from psychiatric hospitals (55%) were discharged within two weeks of admission, compared with 26% from private hospitals. Average length of stay was longest for discharges from private hospitals, at 34.2 days (median 28 days), followed by psychiatric hospitals, at 24.0 days (median 10 days), and general hospital psychiatric units, at 23.3 days (median 11 days).

#### Child and adolescent admissions

There were 367 admissions for children and adolescents under 18 years of age in 2009. This is a decrease in admissions from 2008 (406). Seventy-four per cent of all admissions were first admissions, a slight increase in first admissions from 2008 (72%).

## Hospital type

There were 155 admissions to specialist child and adolescent units and 83% of these were first admissions. Admissions to specialist child and adolescent units accounted for 42% of all admissions for children and adolescents in 2009, an increase in admissions from 2008 (35%). Fifty-eight per cent of admissions for under-18s were to adult psychiatric units and hospitals, a reduction in the proportion to similar units and hospitals in 2008 (65%). Most notable in these reductions was a reduction in admissions to psychiatric hospitals from 17% in 2008 to 8% in 2009, and a reduction in admissions to private hospitals from 10% in 2008 to 8% in 2009. There was an increase in the proportion of admissions to general hospital psychiatric units from 38% in 2008 to 42% in 2009.

#### Gender and age

Females accounted for 55% of all and 52% of first admissions for persons under 18 years of age. Forty-five per cent of all admissions were aged 17 years on admission, 30% were aged 16 years, 13% were aged 15 years, 5% were aged 14 years and 7% were aged 6–13 years. From 1 July 2009 an Addendum to the Code of Practice relating to the Admission of Children under the Mental Health Act 2001 states that no child under 16 years is to be admitted to an adult unit in an approved centre except in exceptional circumstances. There were 11 admissions for under-16s to general hospital psychiatric units in 2009.

#### **Diagnosis**

Depressive disorders accounted for 27% of all and 28% of first admissions for under-18s. Twelve per cent of all admissions had a diagnosis of neurosis and 11% each had a diagnosis of schizophrenia and eating disorders. Males accounted for almost 55% of all admissions for depressive disorders and almost 43% of admissions for schizophrenia. Females accounted for 67% of all admissions with neuroses and 90% of all admissions with eating disorders.

## Length of stay

Almost all those (99%) admitted in 2009 were discharged in 2009. Just over one-third were discharged within one week of admission, 12% within one to two weeks of admission, 15% within two to four weeks of admission, 29% within one to three months of admissions and 11% within three months to one year of admission. The average length of stay for under-18s admitted and discharged in 2009 was 34.4 days (median 17 days), with discharges from specialist child and adolescent units having the longest average length of stay, at 61.9 days (median 58 days), followed by private hospitals, at 31.8 days (median 23 days), psychiatric hospitals, at 14.5 days (median 4 days), and general hospital psychiatric units, at 11.4 days (median 5 days). It is noteworthy that the average length of stay for under-18s, at 34.4 days (median 17 days), was longer than adult units and hospitals, at 25.8 days (median 14 days).
