^[1] It should be noted that in addition to services provided by HSE Addiction Services, other Areas of the HSE provide services to clients with addiction problems including Health Promotion, Mental Health, Acute Hospital Services and Emergency Departments, Primary Care Services and General Practitioners providing front line services for these clients.

² These figures include addiction related expenditure for the North West (Donegal, Sligo, Leitrim)

The drop in expenditure compared to expenditure 2010 and allocation 2011 is attributed to the public sector pay cut, HSE staffing redundancies and the reduction in funding to Voluntary and Community organisations (S 38 and s39 funding)
