
The Drugs Wheel



Outer ring

Established substances

Inner ring

Newer psychoactive substances

Stimulants

Racing heartbeat, sweating, energy, confidence, well-being, euphoria, lowered appetite, clenched jaws, dilated pupils, paranoia, anxiety, mood swings, arousal, impotence

Empathogens

Belonging, connection, understanding, energy, serotonin syndrome, sexual arousal, erectile dysfunction, sweat, warmth, overheat, overdose, risk of dehydration or overhydration

Psychedelics

Spiritual connection, hallucinations, loss of control, heightened senses, opening doors of perception, panic, mood swings, arousal, fear, vomiting, mental health harms

Dissociatives

Euphoria, floaty, relaxed, happy, pain-free, numb, safe, protected, unconscious, unaware, in a 'hole', visual or auditory hallucinations, scared, disconnected, vulnerable

Depressants

Relaxed, confident, care-free, risk-taking, unconscious, coma, euphoria, death, disinhibited behaviours, blackouts, sleep, vomiting, nausea, aggression, dependence

Opioids

Confident, pain-free, safe, sleepy, warm, feel invincible, itchy, constricted pupils, stop breathing, nausea, vomiting, euphoria, sweaty, overdose, dependence, withdrawal

Cannabinoids

Calm, relaxed, chilled out, floaty, reduced pain, paranoia, anxiety, loss of memory, bloodshot eyes, increased sensuality, dry mouth, overexcited, changes to appetite
