Calculation of Index: Code primary school or less = 1, to completed college = 5, treating 'don't know/does not apply as missing. The mean of these items gives a measure of parental education.

Calculation of Indices: The various combination that are marked by respondents can yield a variety of measuring including: (I) single parent family, (ii) re-structured family, (iii) living with extended family.
