New HIV infections are increasing among people who inject drugs



ALL DRUG USERS SHOULD:



- Use safe injecting practices
- Always use clean needles & syringes
- Never share or re-use any injecting equipment



- Practice safer sex
- Always use condoms



- Injecting any drug is high risk behaviour
- This includes snowblow and other head shop drugs
