Life Expectancies & General Health

Life expectancy at birth in 2015-17 was **78.5** years for males and **82.3** years for females.

Healthy life expectancy at birth in 2015-17 was **59.1** years for males and **60.3** years for females.

In 2017/18, **70%** of adults described their **health as** 'good' or 'very good'.

Mental Health & Wellbeing

There were **16.5** suicide deaths per 100,000 population in 2015-17.



In 2017/18, **18%** of respondents **scored highly** (≥4) on the General Health Questionnaire (**GHQ12**) which could indicate a mental health problem.

Premature Mortality

The preventable mortality rate stood at **207** deaths per 100,000 population in 2013-17.

There were **74** deaths per 100,000 population aged under 75 years due to **circulatory disease** in 2013-17.

The under 75 death rate due to **respiratory disease** in 2013-17 was **34** deaths per 100,000 population.

There were **149** deaths per 100,000 population aged under 75 years due to cancer in 2013-17.

Major Diseases & Conditions

In 2015/16 - 17/18 there were **2,062** admissions per 100,000 population due to **circulatory disease**, and **2,074** due to **respiratory disease**.



The number of new cases of **cancer** diagnosed in 2010-16 stood at **596** incidences per 100,000 population.

In 2017, there were **225** persons per 1,000 population prescribed **antihypertensive** drugs.

Alcohol, Drugs & Smoking



Smoking prevalence among adults stood at **18%** in 2017/18.

In 2015/16-17/18, there were **691 alcohol related admissions** per 100,000 population.

In 2017/18, **77%** of adults reported drinking alcohol.

The **emergency** admission rate stood at **9,234** admissions per 100,000 population.

There were **10,884 day case** admissions per 100,000 population in 2017/18.
