

## Drowning data 2018

103 people drowned in Ireland in 2018, six fewer than in 2017 when 109 drowned. This is the lowest figure in eighty years, when 89 drowned in 1939.

The average number of drownings each year is now 124, down from 127 (based on a ten year average to give due consideration to varying weather-related consumer behaviour).
