



HBSC Ireland 2018:

Alcohol use, procurement and location of alcohol use and cannabis use among school-aged children in Ireland

Introduction

The Health Behaviour in School-aged Children (HBSC) study is a cross-national research study conducted in collaboration with the World Health Organisation (WHO) Regional Office for Europe and runs on a four-year cycle. In 2018, Ireland participated for the sixth time in the HBSC study (<u>www.nuigalway.ie/hbsc</u>). The overall aims of the HBSC study are to gain new insight into, and increase our understanding of young people's health and well-being, health behaviours and their social context. HBSC collects data on key indicators of health, health attitudes, and health behaviours, as well as the context of health for young people. The study is a school-based survey with information collected from students through self-completion questionnaires in classrooms. HBSC Ireland 2018 was funded by the Department of Health. The most recent HBSC Ireland study was conducted in 2018 and included 15,557 school-children from 3rd class in primary school to 5th year in post-primary school. Collectively, 255 primary and post-primary schools across Ireland participated in this study. The methods employed comply with the International HBSC protocol and are detailed in the national report from the 2018 survey see http://www.nuigalway.ie/hbsc/hbscireland/2018study/.

Focus of this report

This short report presents a brief analysis of alcohol use, alcohol availability and location of alcohol consumption use and cannabis use among Irish school-children aged 13 to 17 years old, across the country, broken down by age and gender. Overall, data from 5,265 school-children aged 13-17 were analysed.











The HBSC Ireland questionnaire measures alcohol use with the following questions:

Alcohol Use:

- On how many days (if any) have you drank alcohol? Responses options for the time frames 'in your lifetime' and 'in the last 30 days were'; Never, 1-2 days, 3-5 days, 6-9 days, 10-19 days, 20-29 days, 3- days or more (*Table 1 and 2*)
- Have you ever had so much alcohol that they were really drunk? Responses options for the time frames 'in your lifetime' were; Never, 1-2 days, 3-5 days, 6-9 days, 10-19 days, 20-29 days, 3- days or more (*Table 3*)
- At what age did you do the following things? Responses for drink alcohol (more than a small amount) and get drunk were; Never, 11 years old, 12 years old, 13 years old, 14 years old, 15 years old, 16 years or older (*Table 4 and 5*)
- At present, how often do you drink anything alcoholic, such as beer, wine or spirits? Response options for the beverages 'Beer (Guinness, lager)', 'Wine, Spirits/Liquor (e.g. vodka, whiskey, shots, brandy, etc.)', 'Alcopops (e.g. Bacardi Breezer, Smirnoff Ice)', 'Cider (Bulmers, Scrumpy)', and 'Any other drink that contains alcohol' were; Every day, Every week, Every month, Rarely, Never (*Table 6 to 11*)

Procurement and Location of Alcohol use:

- In the area where you live and go to school, how easy or difficult would it be for you to buy alcohol? Responses options were; Very easy, Easy, Neither easy nor difficult, Difficult, Very difficult (*Table 12*)
- In the area where you live and go to school, how easy or difficult would it be for you to get someone else to buy alcohol for you? Responses options were; Very easy, Easy, Neither easy nor difficult, Difficult, Very difficult (*Table 13*)
- On the last occasion when you drank alcohol, where did you get the alcohol? (please tick all that apply). Response options were; I have never drank alcohol, A parent/guardian gave it to me, I took it from my home, Bought in a supermarket/convenience store, Bough in a garage shop, Bought in a pub/bar/disco, Bought in an off-license, Ordered online or by phone and delivered, Friends gave it to me, Brother/Sisters gave it to me, I have someone else money to buy it for me, Some other way (*Table 14*)
- Think of the last day on which you drank alcohol. Where were you when you drank? (please tick all that apply). Response options were; I never drink alcohol, At home, At someone else's











home, Out on the street, in a park, beach or other open area, At a bar or a pub, In a disco, In a restaurant, Some other place (*Table 15*)

Cannabis Use:

- Have you ever taken cannabis (hashish, grass, pot)? Responses for the timeframes 'in your lifetime', 'in the last 12 months' and 'in the last 30 days' were; Never, 1-2 days, 3-5 days, 6-9 days, 10-19 days, 20-29 days, 3- days or more (*Table 16, 17 and 18*)
- At what age did you do the following things? Responses were; Never, 11 years old, 12 years old, 13 years old, 14 years old, 15 years old, 16 years or older (*Table 19*)
