
EU Early Warning System on NPS — 25 years

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In 2022, the EU Early Warning System (EWS) on new psychoactive substances (NPS) celebrates its 25th anniversary. Operated by the EU drugs agency (EMCDDA) in close cooperation with Europol and other partners, it was the first regional early-warning mechanism set up to monitor and respond to uncontrolled new drugs.

EU Early Warning System on NPS

Early warning is the first stage in a three-step legal framework designed to allow the European Union to rapidly detect, assess and respond to health and social threats caused by NPS.


Definition of NPS

A new psychoactive substance is defined as a new narcotic or psychotropic drug, in pure form or in preparation, that is not controlled by the United Nations drug conventions, but which may pose a public health threat comparable to that posed by substances listed in these conventions.
