## Re PQ No. 39253/22

To ask the Minister for Health the average waiting time by facility for addiction rehabilitation and detox services.

Dear Deputy Gould,

I refer to your above Parliamentary Question which had been referred by the Minister for Health to the Health Service Executive for direct response.

An analysis of the data provided in residential services within the National Drugs Treatment Reporting System (NDTRS) (see information about the NDTRS). Waiting time is calculated here as the number of days between date referred for treatment and date treatment commenced. Addiction treatment services may have different entry policies; therefore, data may not be directly comparable and should be interpreted with caution.

Under Action 5.1.47 of the National Drugs Strategy 2017-2025, all publicly funded drug and alcohol services are required to return data to the NDTRS. The analysis includes cases treated for problem alcohol or other drug use as a main problem in residential treatment services in Ireland in 2021. This includes cases treated in residential detoxification services and those who received a detoxification in a residential service. Once the exclusion criteria as outlined above were applied, 3,496 cases were treated in residential addiction rehabilitation and detox services in 2021. Of these 431 cases were treated in specialised inpatient detoxification services (Table 1).

In 2021, the median wait time for treatment for all cases treated in residential services was 20 days. This indicates that half of cases waited less than 20 days and half waited more than 20 days for treatment. Wait time for treatment varied across service providers. The median wait time (days) for treatment in 2021, for individual residential addiction services is outlined (Table 2).
