



In your local area, do you think that in the past few years problems caused by drugs have: (%) [Q4]






Which of the following would you say are problems associated with trafficking of drugs in your local area? (% "Yes") [Q2b]

Base: respondents who regard trafficking of drugs as a problem in their local area





Is drug use the most important cause, one of the causes or not a cause at all of the following types of crime in your local area? (%) [Q3]




## Access to illicit drugs
