To ask the Minister for Health to provide a list of all community outpatient detox services in Ireland; and if she will make a statement on the matter.

Dear Deputy Wall,

The Health Service Executive have been requested to reply directly to your above Parliamentary Question which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

The HSE advises that it currently provides outpatient access to community detoxification services nationwide. These services may be accessed through several different routes, including the following:

- Attendance at a Primary Care service where, after a clinical evaluation, the GP can institute a detoxification for alcohol related problems
- Attendance at a Level 2 GP who can initiate an Opioid detoxification in the Community. At the end of December 2025, there were 90 Level 2 GPs prescribing in the country
- Attendance at a local HSE Addiction Service where prescribing is available. At the end of December 2025, there were 83 HSE Addiction Clinics nationally.
